In addition to the essay, the following information will also be required for applications for the Financial Literacy Awareness Scholarship Program:

- Full Name
- University/college name
- Class year (year of high school graduation)
- Major (and proof of major)
- Contact Information: Phone, E-mail, also feel free to include sources like a Facebook profile, etc.
- A copy of academic transcripts (official or unofficial both okay)

By submitting an application for this scholarship, each applicant must be of 18 years of age or older at the time of application and agrees that their name and/or image may be used in LoanMart promotional materials such as, but not limited to, newsletters, online blogs, website, brochures and press releases.

The LoanMart Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, social class, gender or sexual orientation.
