FINANCIAL LITERACY AWARENESS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Financial literacy is particularly important for young adults. Learning about economic terms, trends, and concepts early on in life, allows young adults to be better informed when they make important financial decisions later on as adults. LoanMart believes in promoting financial literacy in young adults and wants to reward and incentivize young adults who have taken the time to learn about financial literacy.

Any student in the graduating class of a high school, who is a citizen or permanent resident of the United States of America, may submit an application.

The following must be included in all submissions:

- 1. Completed Scholarship Application form (attached);
- 2. Transcript reflecting academic standing; and
- 3. An essay of not more than 750 words summarizing the importance of financial literacy in your life or community, or about a resource, tool, or program that could be established to promote financial literacy in your community through the use of technology. Don't be afraid to think outside of the box!

While not required, applicants are encouraged to provide additional evidence of notable achievements in scholarship, leadership, extracurricular activities or community service.

Applications will only be accepted if they are presented in an orderly, concise and chronological manner. Exhibits demonstrating notable achievements in scholarship, leadership, extracurricular activities or community service may be attached, but the applicant should avoid submitting repetitious accounts of the same aptitude. Elaborate presentation is unnecessary. An application, including exhibits, should be confined to fewer than 20 pages in length (one side only). Mailed applications should be bound by a staple or paper clip.

The LOANMART SCHOLARSHIP AWARD is for one year only and is not renewable.

All scholarships are conditioned upon the enrollment of the student in an undergraduate course in an accredited college or university. Upon submission of evidence of enrollment, payment in the amount of \$2,000.00 will be paid directly to the college, university, or vocational school for tuition or fees in accordance with IRS regulations.

By submitting an application for this scholarship, each applicant is agreeing that their name and/or image may be used in LoanMart promotional materials such as, but not limited to, newsletters, website, brochures and/or press releases.

The LoanMart Scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation.
